### **Conditioned Based Maintenance**

Jerry Larkin's paper will deal with the practice of Conditioned Based Maintenance and will address matters such as the routine or continuous interpretation of data to indicate the condition of an item, the use of measuring indicating parameters such as vibration or temperature, the chosen parameter being used as a measure of condition.
