Synopsis of Lecture

New National Guidelines for the Control of Legionnaires' Disease have been published for Ireland. These guidelines explain the legislative requirements and what is considered to be best practice for preventing or controlling risk, including specific requirements for:

- Risk Assessment
- Training and Competence
- Monitoring (Including Cooling Towers)
- Risk Control Measures
- Good Design Practice

The document will be summarised and explained. Requirements for various commercial, healthcare and leisure facilities will be examined. Maintenance requirements for water systems and cooling towers will also be examined.
