Description

The Cork County Hall development comprised of the refurbishment and extension of the existing Cork County Council headquarters at the Carrigrohane Road, Cork. The new three-storey extension provided a concourse, a new council chamber and associated office accommodation and canteen facilities. The general refitting out of all floors in the existing 16-storey tower building.

Of particular interest was the replacement on all elevations the non-structural concrete cruciform's with a system of climatically responsive glass louvers. The scheme also includes the replacement of the existing floor to ceiling glazing with a new thermally broken glazing system. The provision of glazed pavilion at rooftop level, associated site works, landscaping and multi-storey parking facilities.
