The Capital Projects Office of the Buildings and Estates Directorate at University College Cork manages the capital programme of the University. The University is currently going through the largest capital programme in its history. This involves at any time up to 15 live projects and an overall capital spend of €50 million/annum with an overall programme value in the region of €430 million.


This paper looks at the history of capital projects and the urban/suburban University location debate; reviews UCC's capital programme of the last 10 years - a time of unprecedented activity at the University; addresses the alignment of the Building & Estates Department strategic plan with the overall University strategic plan; and takes a look ahead at some upcoming projects and construction activity at UCC.
