Seminar Overview:

European directives lay down certain end results that must be achieved in every Member State. National authorities have to adapt their laws to meet these goals, but are free to decide how to do so. Directives are used to bring different national laws into line with each other, and are particularly common in matters affecting the operation of the single market (e.g. product safety standards).

The New Approach Directives and European standardisation are an integral part of the development of the European Single Market.

The European standardisation system plays a vital role in ensuring the free movement of goods between all Member States by removing technical barriers to trade.

However, our experience has shown that there can be an unawareness of the roles, responsibilities and how they relate to our various industrial sectors.

This 1 day seminar will comprise a series of short presentations looking at the roles, key definitions and core directives and will touch on implications and obligations for Clients, Owners, Operators, Maintenance Personnel, Designers and Owner's Engineers.
