The Elysian Project, Cork

The Elysian Project in Cork is a mixed-use development located on the southern approach to the city centre. Occupying a site area of 3 acres, the development includes a two-storey basement car park over the entire site with retail and office units at ground and mezzanine levels. Landscaped gardens have been created at Podium level over an area of 1 acre. These gardens are bounded by five and six storey perimeter residential buildings. A signature 18 storey residential Tower is located at the south west corner of the site. This presentation provides a review of the project in terms of Civil/Structural design and highlights the key planning and construction operations from the contractor's perspective.
