About This Event

Ireland has set itself the ambitious challenges of increasing renewable generation to 70% of demand by 2030. Small-scale and community renewable generation can play an important role in achieving these targets. Achieving a grid connection for a renewable project can be challenging due to the substantial capacity of renewable generation already connected and the large number of projects in development. This lecture will outline the process and challenges for the connection of small scale renewable generation (11kW to 5MW).
