

Port of Cork Tour

About: The Port of Cork is the key seaport in the south of Ireland and is one of only two Irish ports which serves the requirements of all six shipping modes i.e. Lift-on Lift-off, Roll-on Roll-off, Liquid Bulk, Dry Bulk, Break Bulk and Cruise. The port is classified as a Tier 1 port of national significance and has made impressive strides in recent decades. The Port of Cork owns and operates facilities in Cork City Quays, Tivoli, Ringaskiddy and Cobh and recently acquired Marino Point.

In 2015 An Bord Pleanála granted a 10-year planning permission to Port of Cork for the redevelopment of the existing port facilities at Ringaskiddy. The €80 million port redevelopment will future proof the facility and serve the needs of both port customers and the region. The Port of Cork is a commercial semi-state body employing up to 120 employees.

During your tour you will visit the very historic headquarters of the Port of Cork at Custom House, you will be taken by bus to Tivoli Container Terminal to see first-hand how the port operates 365 days/ 7 days a week/ 24 hours. The tour will also cover the Ringaskiddy Deepwater berth where you will get an appreciation of the site and the planned port redevelopments.
