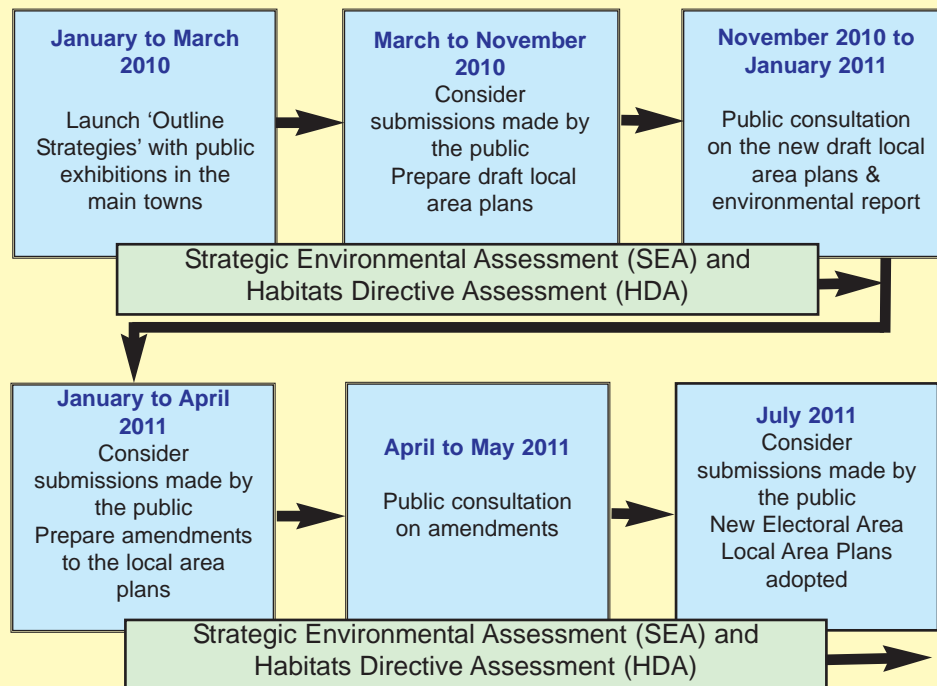


What happens next in the Review Process?

What is a Local Area Plan?

Local Area Plans -

- Set out the County Council's vision on how each 'Electoral Area' should develop while respecting the environment
- Set out the planning policies and objectives for each 'Electoral Area'
- Include 'zoning maps' for the towns, villages and rural areas
- Must be consistent with the County Development Plan 2009
- Were first prepared in 2005 and must be reviewed before September 2011

To begin the review of the local area plan for each Electoral Area an 'Outline Strategy' has been prepared in order to stimulate debate.

The 'Outline Strategy':

- Sets out an assessment of the main changes that have taken place
- Contains a statement of the current supply of zoned land for new development
- Identifies infrastructure needed in the area and measures to protect the environment
- Identifies the important planning issues & choices now faced
