## About This Event

The Dingle Project is one of ESB Networks' flagship innovation projects. Kicked off in late 2018, the technical trials on the project will draw to a close at the end of 2021. These trials have been exploring the impact of renewable and clean energy enabling technologies, installed in homes and small business premises, to determine their impact on and how they might support the local electricity network. The project is also exploring what mechanisms might contribute to a greater take-up of these technologies across communities and what is needed to activate the energy citizen. Other trials have been exploring the use of new technologies on the electricity network to enhance its reliability for all customers, whether through minimising the occurrence of specific types of faults or by enabling faster resolution.

At this event, ESB Networks will provide an update on progress, some of the learnings to date and the work ahead over the coming months
